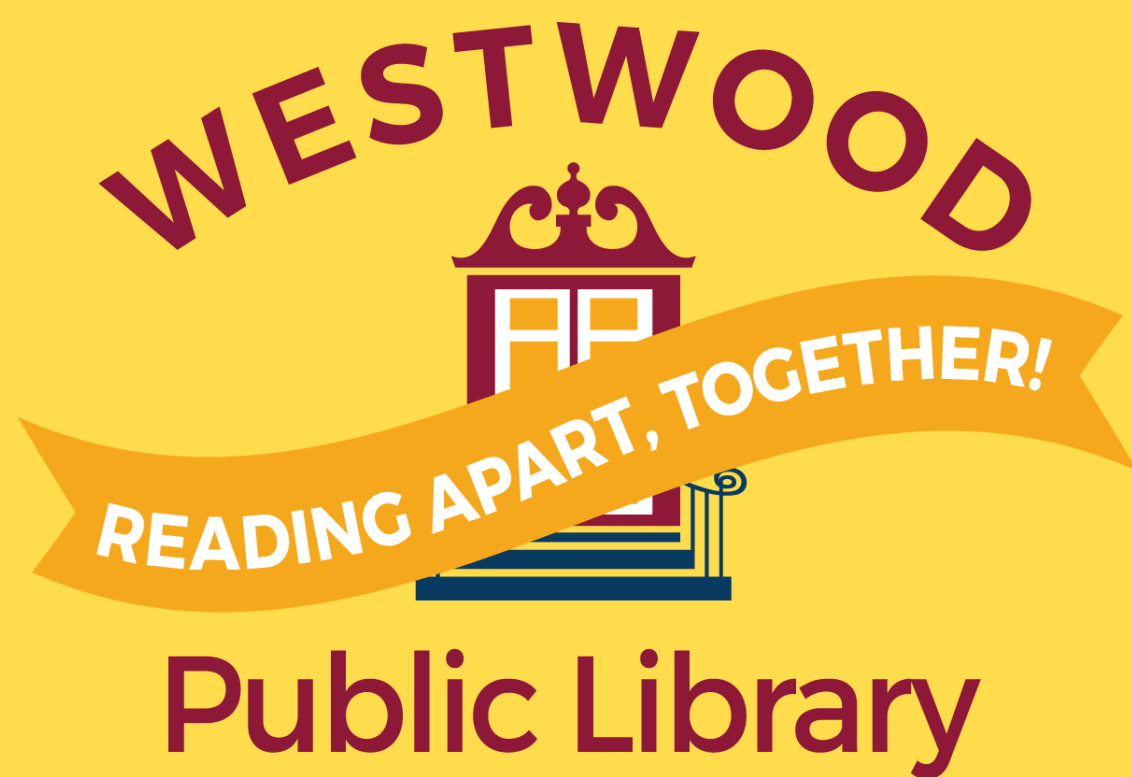

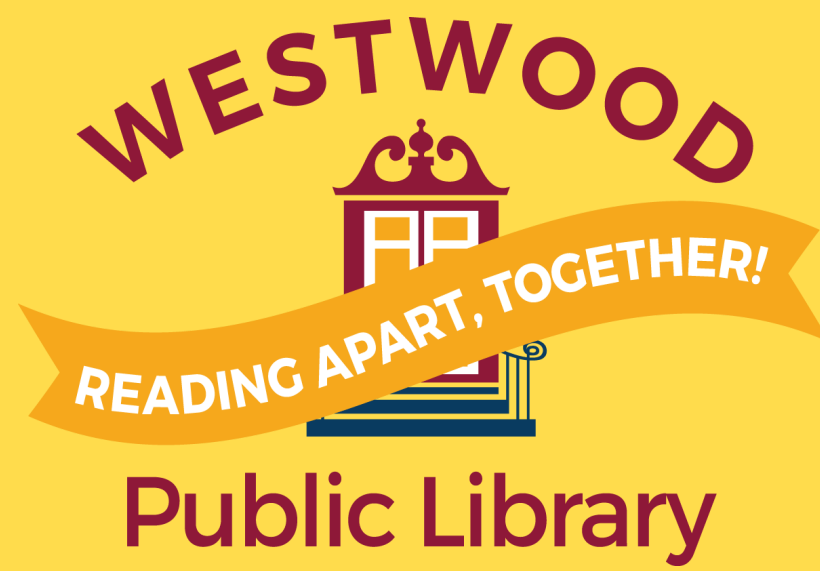

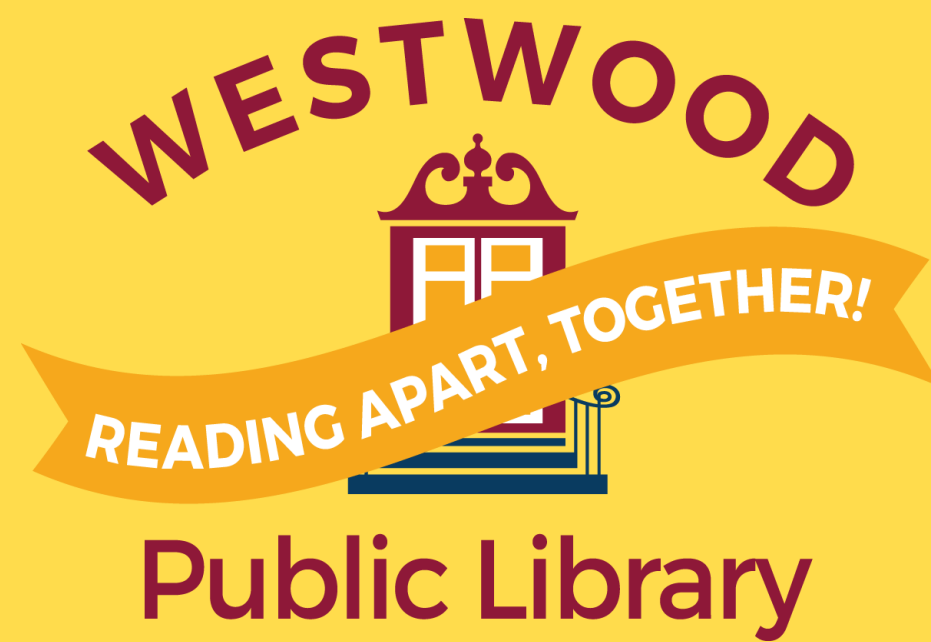


Mission Statement

JLC is a Service-learning Group. This means there is a principle-centered partnership between community and schools. Members will work with the library and/or its committees to identify and serve a library/community need.

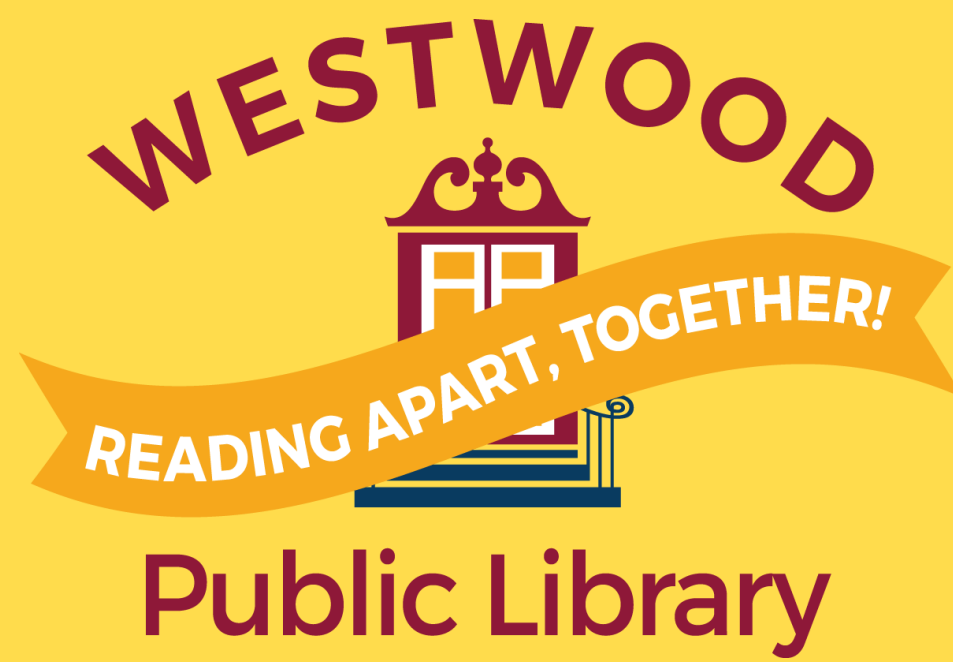


Enrollment

Students must be in Grades 6th-12th to enroll.

Meetings will be held once per month (October - May) either virtually on Google Meet or in-person to monitor student projects and progress.

Students must be actively working on a project that benefits the library and community.

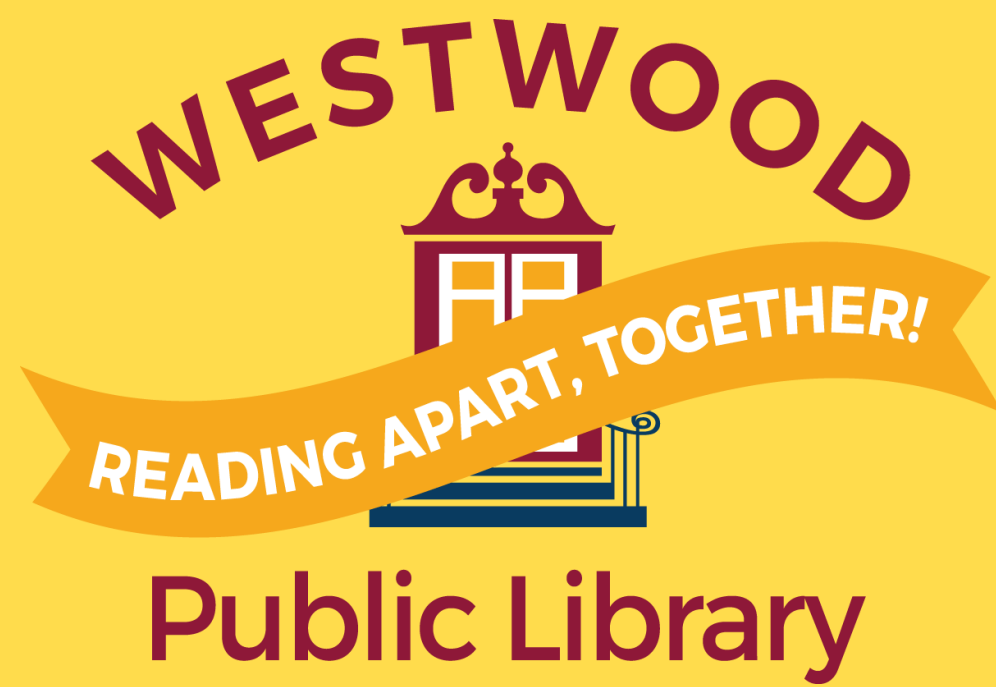


Volunteer Hours

The JLC requires 15 hours of service which can be applied towards other organizational groups such as, Scouts, religious institutions, schools, scholarships, etc.

Scheduling Hours

Member hours will be tracked individually via an Excel spreadsheet by library staff and monthly updates will be provided via email.



Suggested Monthly Activities

Write a review or film a trailer for a book, movie or video game that the library owns.

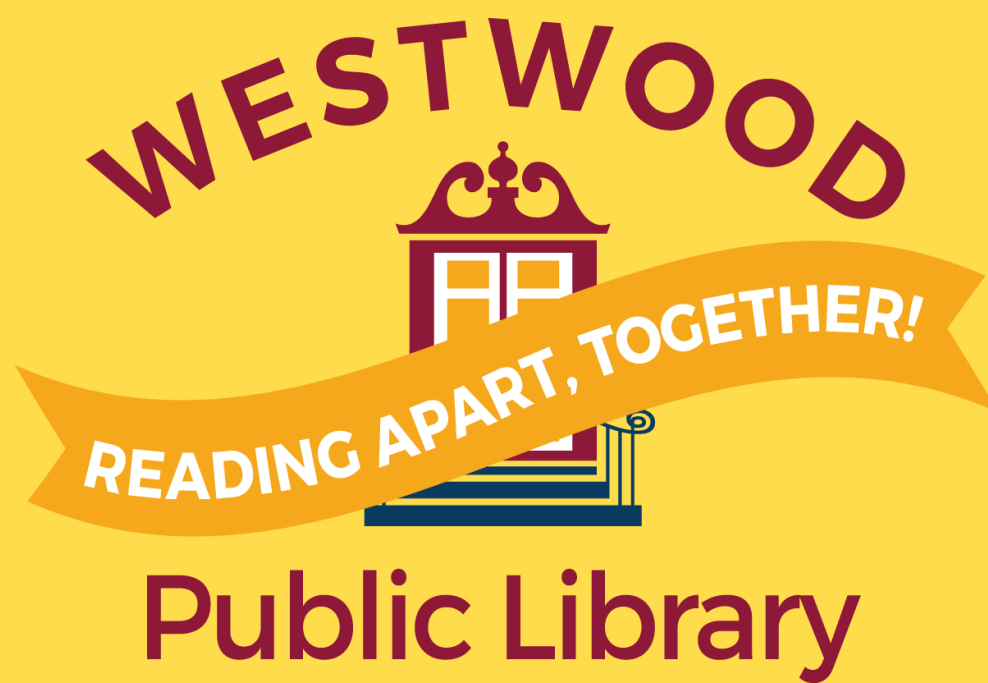
Choose a science activity through Citizen Science that helps with scientific research.

Write letters to U.S. active soldiers or senior citizens who reside at Westwood House.

Align with a local charitable organization for a “drive” (toy drive, women’s shelter, sneaker drive, pet drive, food drive or book drive). The drive can be done as a group activity.

Contribute to library programming by leading a program for children in grades K-5. The program can be academic based (STEM) or recreational (chess, language, magic, pre-recorded story time, etc)

Volunteer to assist at town functions (Home for the Holidays, Ragamuffin Parade)

Watch all 3 youth empowerment leadership videos (on your own time), total 1 hour service. Links are below:

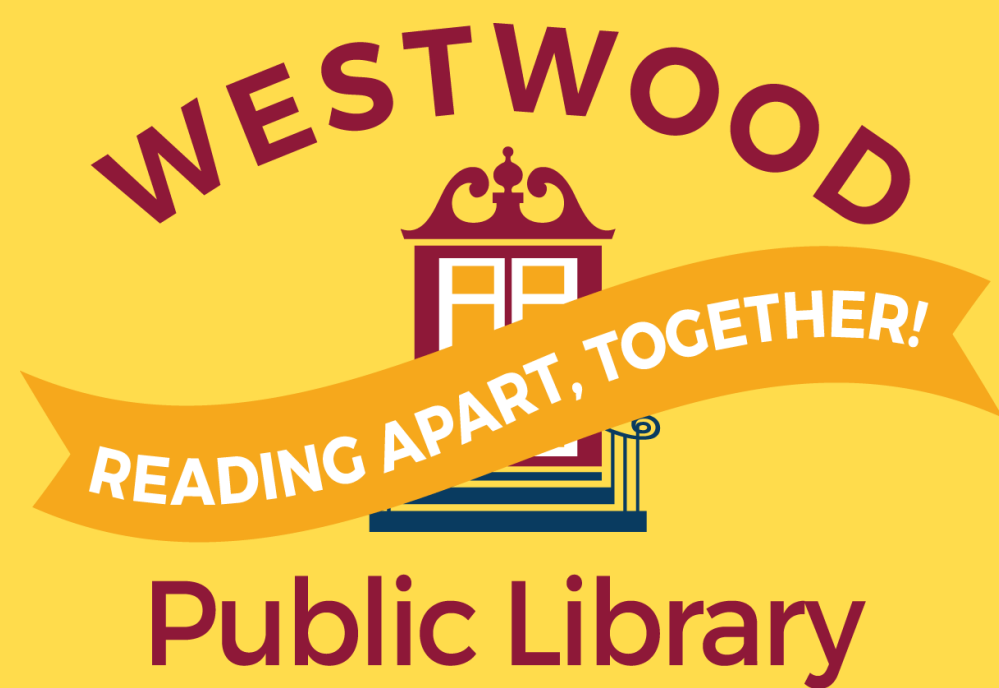

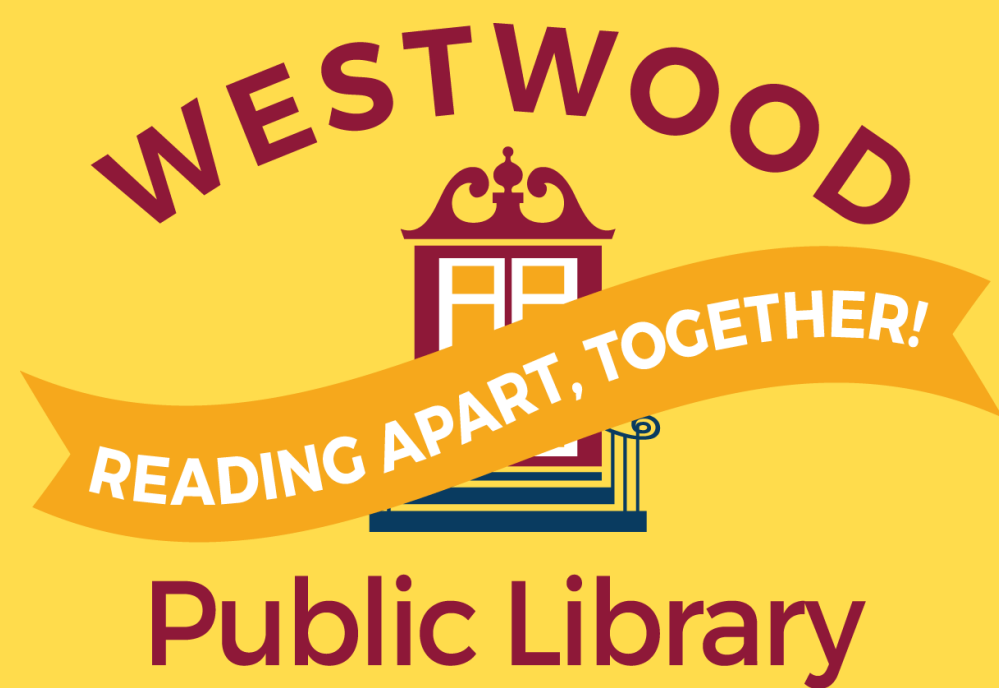
